

Reader Response Letter (Due Friday)

Each week you are expected to read for at least 20 minutes each night, and write a Reader Response Letter about what you have read (due Friday). If you have read more than one book during the week, pick one to write about. Use your best handwriting and politely ask an adult to check it when it is finished. Make corrections if you find any mistakes. Please use pencil and wide-ruled paper with 3 holes.

EXAMPLE:

September 2, 2018

Dear Ms. Raney,

The fantasy book that I am reading this week is Poppy by Avi. I picked it because it reminded me of a book about a mouse that I read with my dad. One interesting event so far is when Poppy has to confess to the mouse colony that she broke the rules and a tragedy occurred. When that happened I think Poppy felt guilty, sad, and worried about being punished. I was impressed that she was honorable enough to tell the truth even though she knew she would get in trouble. I looked at the author's website, and I think I might like to read Ereth next because it has a lot of the same characters.

You MUST include:

- Letter format (heading, greeting, body, closing, signature)
- Genre, title, and author (The genre book that I am reading this week is Title by Author.)
- Why you picked the book (I picked this book because __.)
- At least 3 more sentences, which makes at least 5 sentences total

Optional Sentence Starters (helpful if you're feeling stuck):

- I think character felt __ when __.
- Character made a clever/foolish/kind/cruel decision when __.
- I predict that __ because __.
- I wonder __?
- When __ happened, it reminded me of __.
